CHANGE IN THE REPORTING CURRENCY OF THE CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

San Pedro Garza García, N.L., Mexico; February 23, 2022 - GRUMA, S.A.B. de C.V. ("GRUMA") (BMV: GRUMAB), announces that based on the International Accounting Standard 21, "Effects of Changes in Foreign Exchange Rates" (IAS 21) of the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) has decided to change the reporting currency from the Mexican peso to the U.S. dollar in its consolidated financial statements. This change in the reporting currency was approved by GRUMA's Board of Directors with the prior favorable opinion of the Audit Committee. This change will take effect from January 1, 2022, including quarterly financial information as of March 31, 2022, and in each subsequent quarter, GRUMA will be using the U.S. dollar as the reporting currency for the consolidated financial information.

The change of the reporting currency from the Mexican peso to the U.S. dollar will facilitate the analysis for the different users of GRUMA's consolidated financial information, including easier comparability with the financial reports of other global entities.
